

Psychiatrists (part time) Integrated Community Access Program

WHO WE ARE:

Ontario Shores Centre for Mental Health Sciences (Ontario Shores) is a state-of-the-art 328-bed public hospital that provides a range of inpatient, outpatient and consultation services for people with complex mental illness. Ontario Shores serves a population of 2.5 million residents and employs over 1000 people. Our patients benefit from a recovery-oriented environment of care built on compassion, inspiration and hope. We engage in research, education and advocacy initiatives to advance the mental health care system and are proud to work with partners across the continuum of care. If you thrive on innovation and positive change, and share our vision of Recovering Best Health, Nurturing Hope and Inspiring Discovery, Ontario Shores is the place for you.

The **Integrated Community Access** Program (ICAP) is a Central Intake service that provides a single point of entry for all inpatient and outpatient services at Ontario Shores. Specialized recovery-oriented staff provides a range of triage, intake, system navigation, assessment, treatment and outpatient follow-up. The physicians and interdisciplinary staff are integrating best practice with evidence based treatment, and incorporating strategies and philosophies such as Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) for psychosis, illness management, and recovery.

We are seeking psychiatrists to support the expansion of our existing interprofessional outpatient clinics:

1. **Prompt Care Clinic:** provides rapid triage and consultation services to individuals with deteriorating mental health,
2. **Women's Consultation Service:** provides consultation and brief follow-up to address women's issues in the context of mental illness,
3. **Borderline Personality Self Regulation Clinic:** this clinic provides treatment of individuals with Borderline Personality Disorder, utilizing primarily Dialectical Behavioural Therapy strategies
4. **Psychosis, Mood and Anxiety and Complex General Psychiatry** Clinics provide consultation as well as follow-up services for those struggling with severe and persistent mental illness.

We are also looking to staff our newest clinic for **Post Traumatic Stress Disorder**. The two phased model utilized in this clinic will provide intensive treatment to individuals diagnosed with PTSD based on trauma-focused CBT principles. *For specific program details, visit the Programs and Services page of www.ontarioshores.ca*

Candidates must be eligible for licensure in Ontario and have obtained specialty qualification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or recognized equivalent as well as certification and/or experience in CBT. An academic affiliation with University of Toronto, an interest in or current holding of an academic cross appointment would be a distinct advantage.
